Description This course presents a description of the 2.8L Duramax diesel engine. The course provides a description of the engine's applications and specifications. Other topics are a comprehensive overview of components of the 2.8L diesel engine, and it's after treatment system.

Course Name Diesel Particulate Filter Operation & Diagnosis

Description The course describes how the engine air intake, fuel system, electronic control system calibrations and exhaust system components are re-engineered so that the engine can benefit from the significant emissions reductions that are achieved through the use of Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel fuel in combination with state of the art exhaust after treatment technology. Related diagnostic and service procedures as well as instructions for performing DPF service regeneration process will also be discussed.

Course Name: A/C Compressor Replacement

This 1-hour training session will cover important tips and procedures for replacing A/C compressors to ensure a long service life.

Topics include: system contamination and flushing procedures, and selection of the correct refrigerant oil.

Course Name: Fuel Pump Diagnosis and Replacement Tips

This 1-hour training session will cover important tips and procedures for diagnosing and servicing electric in-tank fuel pump modules. Topics include procedures for fuel tank inspection and cleaning to prevent repeat failures, electrical pigtail service procedures and installation tips.
